Canterbury's Prep to Year 4 students have been creating their own Easter garden pots in Term 1 to help them tell the Easter story at home during the school holidays. College Chaplain Fr Dan Talbot visited the classes during their Canterbury Kitchen Garden lessons, explaining that their potted gardens needed to feature:

A mound to represent the Hill of Golgotha where the crucifixions occurred. Three stick crucifixes, including a larger central cross, for Jesus who died on

A buried empty smaller pot to represent the tomb where Jesus' body was placed.

A pebble path leading to the empty tomb, on which Mary walked and discovered that Jesus was risen.

A rock representing the boulder that was rolled away from the entrance of the tomb, revealing the empty tomb.

Green growth to remind us that God is still working and creating in our world today, just as we can still grow ourselves to be the person God wants us to be. (Focus article)


