From Fr Stephen

The crowds who followed Jesus to Capernaum wanted to make him king, that being the very reason he tried to move away from them. They were people who saw the miracle of the feeding of the five thousand as an end in itself, rather than a sign which pointed them to have faith in the living God. Jesus informed them that they needed to work toward gaining spiritual food that would lead to eternal life, rather than earthly food which would soon spoil. Like the followers to Capernaum we can lose sight of what really matters, we can look for more and more miracles or things we equate to miracles to satisfy our own experiences. We can ask for one sign after another, we can be given signs and still not believe. What we need is soul food, food which will satisfy long after our rice bellies are full. Food that will sustain a life of rejoicing and thanksgiving. Where do we get that food, where is that food freely given? Jesus is the bread of life. Those who come to him will never be hungry, and those who put their trust in him will never thirst. Amen.

There is a virus killing our native frogs. Scientists have discovered that a "frog sauna" available during winter can help frogs fight off the virus. We found directions in a "Guardian" article and are in the process of providing one for our All Saints frog community. The painted black 10 hole bricks X 10 make for a lot of sauna "cubicles"! The bricks are built



over damp earth, and the other half of the sink base will be made into a small pond, covered by a wire mesh to keep Kookaburras out and children safe. We hope to finish it off next week. We are happy to show you where it is, just ask.



In memory of Delys Henderson, this native Thyme (aka. Cut-leaf Mint Bush) was planted at All Saints. This highly aromatic shrub, giving off a minty aroma when crushed or rubbed, was chosen as smell was one of the only senses Delys had left at the end.
