# Energy Saving Tips

#### **ENERGY SAVING TIPS**

Open windows for ventilation to cool rooms ahead of using air conditioning Use overhead or other fans before air conditioning

Use the dehumidifier (dry setting) on your air conditioner instead of cooling Clean air conditioner filters monthly (hose down external filters outdoors) Control cooling and heating temperatures.

Winter: 17-18oC, Summer: 23-25oC

Install ceiling insulation

Own a solar hot water system/heat pump

Set your hot water system temperature maximum to 60 degrees

Use honeycomb cellular blinds or block-out curtains

Use Energy efficient LED lighting

Use the clothesline instead of the dryer

Install solar panels in your home

Invest in green power through your

energy provider

Only fill the kettle to the minimum

amount

Only complete full loads of washing

Only put the dishwasher on when it's full
