Sometimes we can make religion about rules because they are easier to enforce or amend than showing compassion and forgiveness. Of all the disciples that followed Jesus, and there were many, only the chosen twelve were willing to remain by Jesus' side. Jesus though did ask them if they too wanted to go away and Peter answered, "Lord, to whom can we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and know that you are the Holy One of God." In that very moment Peter realized that despite the confronting images, despite the hard path, he is ready to give up some control in order to go home, in order to accept the gift of life. The moment we to fully ingest Jesus, when we abide in him and he abides in us – we choose life. When we give up the notion we are in control, fear no longer has the upper hand. At that moment we understand that we are no better than anyone else but that we are all loved children of God.
