ELIMINATE SINGLE-USE ITEMS

Commit to phasing out single-use plastics and disposables. Start small: carry reusable cutlery, refuse plastic straws, and invest in long-lasting alternatives like metal razors. Have a "keep cup". Try beeswax wraps instead of cling wrap. Save plastic bags on bought items and use them again at home.

Try not to buy goods packaged in plastic. The global production of plastics accounts for 1.8bn metric tons of greenhouse gas emissions annually and reducing demand can help stem this tide. Beeswax wraps are available in Woolies also at beeswaxwraps.com.au
