ABM sells used stamps to assist community projects in Australia and overseas. Boxes at All Saints and St Matthews are provided to collect them.


#### RECYCLING

Plastic pollution permeates every corner of the planet—even in our bodies in the form of microplastics. World Environment Day June 5 2025 calls for collective action to tackle plastic pollution.

In 2025, the world is expected to consume <u>516 million tonnes</u> of plastics.

By 2060, annual global plastic consumption is forecast to reach <u>over 1.2 billion tonnes</u>.

By drawing inspiration from nature and showcasing real-world solutions, the campaign will encourage individuals, organizations, industries,

and governments to adopt sustainable practices that drive systemic change. This year's World Environment Day comes exactly two months before countries meet again in Korea to continue negotiating a global treaty to end plastic pollution.
