Words of Hope for a Troubled World – Drawing on the Wisdom of C.S. Lewis In a world marked by war, division, anxiety, and uncertainty, we often ask: Where is hope? What can we hold onto when the news is grim, the future unclear, and suffering all too close?

C.S. Lewis, writing in the aftermath of two world wars, understood this deep ache for peace and meaning. He did not offer shallow optimism or deny the pain of life. But he did offer hope — not wishful thinking, but a hope rooted in eternal truth. In times of trouble, Lewis reminds us, God is not absent.

Rather, God is calling us to something deeper — to look beyond what we see and feel, and to trust in what is eternal. In Mere Christianity, he wrote: "If I find in myself desires which nothing in this world can satisfy, the only logical explanation is that I was made for another world." That doesn't mean we abandon this one. It means we live with the assurance that God is working even now — redeeming, restoring, and calling us toward His kingdom.

So in our troubled world, let us take heart. God is on the move. Christ has overcome the world. Our task is not to despair, but to live as people of the light—to plant seeds of compassion, to speak truth in love, and to trust that even in chaos, God is shaping something beautiful.

Hope, as Lewis teaches, is not escaping reality — it's living more deeply into it, with faith that "the shadowlands" are not the end of the story. The best is yet to come.

Let us hold fast to that hope.
