From Fr Stephen

St Clare of Assisi (1194 - 1253)

Inspired by the teachings of St. Francis, Clare founded the Order of Poor Ladies, a monastic religious order for women in the Franciscan tradition. The Order of Poor Ladies was different from any other order or convent because it followed a rule of strict poverty. Clare wrote their Rule of Life, the first set of monastic guidelines known to have been written by a woman. Following her death, the order she founded was renamed in her honor as the Order of Saint Clare, commonly referred to today as the Poor Clares. Her feast day is on 11 August. Clare was a woman of great faith and conviction.

"Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not see." (Hebrews 11:1)

Faith matters. Our faith gives us the assurance that God loves us and knows our hopes and dreams yet what awaits is more than we can possibly imagine. Our faith is a gift of God's grace which comes to us by God reaching out through the Holy Spirit and offering us the opportunity to respond to God's initiative of such grace. God is faithful to us and so it is only right to respond in a faith grounded with assurance and conviction.
