Don't forget your keep-cup for morning tea



A council on the New South Wales North Coast wants to reduce the amount of clothing being dumped at its waste centre. An audit found 80 per cent of discarded clothing was in perfect or near-perfect condition. The Ballina Shire Council on the New South Wales North

Coast found more than 80 per cent of 2,000 clothing items arriving at its waste facility during four weeks from June to July were in perfect or near-perfect condition. Fast fashion's core issue is a cycle of low-cost, trendy clothing that creates immense waste, depleting resources and polluting the environment. Key problems include: landfill waste, where garments are quickly discarded; microplastic pollution from synthetic fibers washing into oceans; water consumption and pollution from cotton farming and dyeing; and carbon emissions from global production and transportation.



SUPPORTING YOUR PARISH

Did you know it costs around \$ 682 per day / \$ 4775 per week to keep our parish operational?

Why?

The Parish has to foot all of its wages, building maintenance (2 churches, hall, parish office, rectory) ministry costs and resources, cleaning, utilities, IT, insurances, safe ministry charges, diocesan commitments, etc) by itself. A misconception by some is that the Diocese supports parishes financially (pays stipend, etc), however this is not the case.

Please make sure you take up your part in supporting the work of the church in your parish by giving regularly, generously and with thanksgiving to God.
