# From Saturday, Queenslanders will have some relief from stay-at-home rules. You can:

- Go for a drive
- Ride a motorbike, jet ski or boat for pleasure
- Have a picnic
- Visit a national park
- Shop for non-essential items

#### Three conditions for eased restrictions:

- Social distancing and hygiene must be maintained
- You have to stay within 50 km of home and
- Outings are limited to members of the same household or an individual and one friend

The **<u>Epray Daily</u>** App is now available to everyone, and we strongly encourage parishes to make this known to their



parishioners as an additional prayer tool for their use during these unsure and unsettling times. It is available for both Apple and Android smart phones and tablets. The new Android version that is coming will no longer ask for an app code, but if it still is, you can bypass this by using the code 9999.



Basic tips for managing safety and security on **Zoom:** 

- 1. **Use waiting rooms** The **waiting room** is a helpful feature for hosts to pre-screen guests before the meeting starts and to control who comes and goes (gets admitted). When scheduling a meeting, enable 'waiting room' under 'Advanced Options'.
- 2. **Ensure the host is present** Don't enable participants to join before the host joins. When scheduling a meeting, disable 'join before host' under 'Advanced Options'.
- 3. **Disable participant cameras when joining the meeting** When scheduling a meeting, select video 'off' for participants.
- 4. Lock the meeting Consider locking the meeting once it has started and all invited/welcomed participants have joined. When you lock a Zoom Meeting that's already started, no new participants can join, even if they have the meeting ID and password (if you have required one). To lock a meeting, click 'participants' at the bottom of your Zoom window. In the 'Participants' pop-up, click the 'More' button, then select 'Lock Meeting'.
