From Fr Stephen

An important thing to do prior to a small group starting out is to set some boundaries within the group. These will include being respectful of people's contribution, careful listening, allowing others to speak, contributing in positive ways, ensuring that differences do not become personal, not driving personal agendas, maintaining the confidentiality of the group, taking ownership of our own behaviours and not projecting those onto other group members as if the problem is theirs and not our own. Sometimes we may need to be reminded of these expectations. Not only do we need to remind ourselves what is expected but we may need to lovingly remind each other so that we can correct behaviours which lie outside the boundary or covenant made by the group. I am reminded of these responsibilities within today's readings and when Paul taught the Colossians to admonish each other and forgive each other in love so that they could get on with God's mission as a diverse group of people with a common purpose to spread the Good News of God's love for all humanity.
