Funding a just transition & job creation for fossil-fuel industry workers and communities.

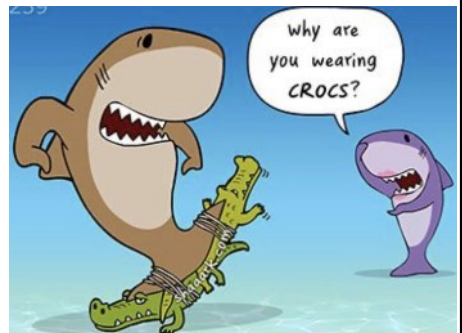
HILDEFEST
