From Fr Stephen

Many people think that religion or faith is a matter of the emotions, of warm, fuzzy feelings. Many can speak of 'experiencing' the presence of God. Certainly there should be some degree of emotional content in a relationship with God, just as there is in human relationships. However, the Bible indicates, over and over again, that a mind change is required. The essential meaning of the word 'repentance' is 'a change of mind' about God, from independence to submission. Once we put our faith in God it then remains necessary to reprogram the mind to think God's ways rather than ours. Much like a computer we start a process of deleting the rubbish and the viruses and downloading the Bible teaching on how to be fully human as God intended.


A GENTLE REMINDER WORSHIP AT 9 AM SERVICE
