THE FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT — HOPE

Priest: Today is the first Sunday in the season of Advent. Advent means 'coming' and in this season, we prepare for the coming of Christ. One of the ways we can celebrate Advent is by making an Advent Wreath and lighting its candles to remind us of the gifts Christ brings to the world.

LA: The Advent wreath includes many symbols. The wreath is in the shape of a circle, showing there is no beginning and no end to God and that God's love and caring for us never ends. The green branches are a sign of new life. The Candles tell us of the light which came into the world with Jesus Christ. The purple colour of the Advent candles symbolizes hope and anticipation. The third Sunday of Advent can be pink, because pink symbolizes joy, the joy that Jesus is almost here. The white candle which we light on Christmas Eve signifies the coming of Christ.

Priest: Today we light the first candle, the candle of Hope. (LA lights the candle)

LA: The people of Israel heard of God's promises through the prophets. The prophet Jeremiah spoke words of hope to Israel. He proclaimed the coming of a leader through whom God's promise of Shalom (peace) would be fulfilled. We too hope and pray for a world of peace and harmony.

Priest: Hope is like a light in a dark place. As we light this candle, we celebrate the hope of Israel, and the hope that we have in Jesus Christ.

All: We continue to live in the hope of God's promise that Christ will come again to fill our lives and the life of the world with Love, Joy and Peace. Thank you God for the Light of Hope. As we prepare for Christ's coming, help us to share and hope with others.
