From Fr Stephen

During Lent we are to pay particular attention to what the wilderness can teach us, how it shapes us and helps us to be more Christ like on our life's journey; to be better Christians. We enter the wilderness to see what God has in store for us, to learn from the experience and strengthen our passion to continue to follow. Importantly we need to appreciate that time in the wilderness is finite: it does not continue indefinitely. Jesus came out of the wilderness after forty days ready to fulfil his incarnational purpose. Follow Jesus into the wilderness we must but we must also follow him out. Jesus emerges to fulfil his ministry, he does not stand still in the face of temptation, he moves forward pushing aside that which troubled him. He cleared a path so to speak so that he can get on

with God's mission in the world by calling all to Repent and believe the Good News. During Lent we are called to Repent and hear the Good News afresh.
